FIELDS OF USE

- Fixing ceramic tiles of all types in medium and small sizes, on indoor walls and floors.
- Fixing ceramic tiles of all types in medium and small sizes outdoors, on walls only.
- Suitable for use when high flexibility is required, such as: fixing on plasterboard or wood.
- Fixing insulating panels made of polystyrene, polyurethane foam, rock or glass wool and cork on absorbent substrates.
- Suitable for fixing in damp places, such as: communal shower facilities and bathrooms.

SUBSTRATES

Cement-based or gypsum-based plaster, plasterboard, wood, cement-lime mortar, concrete, cellular concrete, anhydrite screeds, heating screeds.

NATURE OF THE PRODUCT

TK-7000 mainly consists of high-strength cements, selected silicon/quartz mineral charges and specific additives.

OPERATIONS PRIOR TO APPLICATION

Small hollows in the surfaces must be leveled. In this case, use RASO or RASORAPID respectively 24 h and 6 h before fixing the materials. If the surface is gypsum-based, apply a coat of PRIMER-T before levelling. It is very important to make sure there is no rising damp in the walls. In this case, tiles can only be fixed after water and saline bloom have been eliminated from the wall.

HOW TO PREPARE THE MIXTURE

TK-7000 is ready to use. Just open the can and stir briefly with the trowel before use. The creamy paste obtained can be easily applied by trowel and possesses optimum thixotropy. Once the product has been applied, any left-over adhesive can be kept in the firmly closed can for future use.

WARNINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Do not use:

- in places used to contain water (tanks, swimming pools, etc.)
- do not glue two non-absorbent materials together (e.g.: tiles on tiles)
- for fixing porcelain stoneware in large sizes
- on floors subject to heavy traffic (lift trucks, cars, trucks, etc.)
- on floors subject to rising damp
- for laying outdoor floors
- do not apply at temperatures less than 5°C or more than 35°C
- do not add anything to the product
